Classes start approx 9.00 a.m.

Class 1 Junior Novice - QUALIFIER

Horse/pony not to have won any prize money BSJA.
Jumps 0.76m in the first round, raised by 75mm for the second round.

Class 2 Junior Intermediate/Open - Friendly

Horse/Pony not to have won more than £400 BSJA
Jumps 0.85m in the first round, raised by 75mm for the second round

Class 3 Senior Novice - QUALIFIER

Horse/pony not to have won any prize money BSJA.
Jumps 0.76m in first round raised by 75mm for round two.

Class 4 Senior Intermediate/Open - Friendly

Horse/pony not to have won more than £500 BSJA
Jumps 0.91m in the first round raised by 75mm for round two.

All classes:

Teams of 4, with 3 scores to count.

A jump off against the clock over a shortened course will be jumped in the case of Teams equal after two rounds.
Jumps can be raised at the discretion of the Judge and Official Steward.

Individual entries may be accepted, if entries allow, however no individual is able to qualify.

All other rules please consult the BRC Official Rule Book 2008 (NB changes have been made which affect this competition).

Seniors are riders 17 years and over on 1st January 2008

Please Note:

- **Vaccinations and passports will be checked for the qualifier classes but not for the friendly classes.**
- **Horse/pony names in qualifiers must identically match the names on passports and vaccination cards.**
- A horse can only compete in one of the Novice, Intermediate or Open competitions in the same year.
Not including the Equitation/Style Jumping.
- Running order is subject to change, depending on entries and two phase rules may be applied to friendly classes.
- Approximate times will be sent following entries.

Entries:

5th January 2008 - team numbers and full payment. An email will be sent, confirming individual entries.

18th January 2008 - Names

Don't forget, entries to British Riding Clubs by 5th January for qualifiers.

Late entries, or entries without full payment can not be accepted.

Any entry sent by special or recorded delivery must be scheduled to arrive on Friday, 4th January to allow collection from the post office on Saturday.
